# Small Group Discussion: The Legacy

*Series: The Trophy (Sermon 4)*

**Big Idea:** A godly legacy is never an accident of time, but the intentional fruit of a life that rhythmically sharpens the next generation's heart with the wonderful works of God until His truth becomes their daily walk.

### 1. Our Foundation (Proverbs 13:22)

## 2. Our Function (Psalm 78:4; Proverbs 22:6; Deuteronomy 6:7)

Why do you think God designed discipleship to happen in daily rhythms (sitting, walking, lying down, rising up) rather than just in formal teaching settings? Share one practical way you could begin 'sharpening' someone this week in an ordinary moment.

## 3. Our Fruit (3 John 4; Daniel 12:3)

John says his greatest joy is hearing that his spiritual children walk in truth. What currently brings you the greatest joy? How does your answer reveal what you've actually been investing in?

## Personal Application

**This Week's Challenge:** Choose one daily rhythm (mealtime, bedtime, commute, etc.) and intentionally use it to share God's truth with someone you're discipling. Come prepared next week to share what happened.

## Prayer Focus

Pray for specific people God has placed in your life to disciple. Ask God to give you wisdom, patience, and faithfulness in the daily rhythms of sharpening their hearts with His truth.
